**THE VINEYARDS**

The grapes for Risata Pinot Noir were sourced from Scheid Vineyards in the Salinas Valley of Monterey County, California. Salinas Valley is cooled daily by crisp marine air and rolling fog coming from Monterey Bay, resulting in a long growing season. This cooling down effect yields more "hang time" on the vine which allows the grape clusters to mature gradually and more uniformly. This extended hang time leads to exceptional wines that display intense fruit flavors, deep color extraction and full varietal expression.

**THE WINE**

Luscious fruit notes of cherry, cranberry, raspberry and figs, paired with hints of vanilla, black pepper and nutmeg make an excellent medium-bodied Pinot Noir. This wine can be enjoyed today or can expect to improve for another eighteen to thirty months.
